Marymount College Free Dress Policy

Please note the following requirements regarding the appropriate dress on free dress days at the College. Non-compliance may lead to uniform detention and will result in students being required to change.

Examples of Free Dress days include

- St Patrick's Day, Have a Heart Day, Marymount Day
- Swimming Carnival, Track & Field Carnival
- Camps

The following rules will apply on free dress days

- Normal jewellery and make-up rules apply
- Long hair must be tied back
- Shoes must be enclosed
- Clothing or other items must not be offensive, unsafe, revealing or likely to disrupt the normal school management

The following is NOT permitted on free dress days

- Short shorts
- Midriff tops
- Thongs
- Crocs
- Micro skirts
- Singlet tops
- Rude slogans
- Low cut tops

Special Circumstances

The Marymount College Uniform Policy incorporates strategies to accommodate the special needs and circumstances of students. Please note, that these needs are required to be negotiated between parents, Heads of Year and the Assistant Principal Pastoral Care.

Examples of these special circumstances may include the following:

- Student medical conditions
- Student physical attributes or requirements
- Sport and PE
